

NEW “DO NOT KNOCK” REGISTRY



On February 20, 2018, The Board of Orange Township Trustees approved Resolution #18-083 adopting the Registration and Regulation of all Transient Vendors or “Door-to-Door” sales in Orange Township.

All Transient Vendors, or door-to-door sale persons, are now required to have a Township registered and authorized

Vendor’s Solicitation Permit Certificate carried or exhibited at all times when going door-to-door seeking sales. The Township reviews all vendor applications prior to issuing the certificates, and seeks to insure that the sales and products are legitimate.

Transient Vendor’s are prohibited from selling or soliciting sales anytime between the hours of 8:00 PM and 9:00 AM,

or on Sundays or any legal Holidays. The Delaware County Sheriff’s Department (740-833-2810 or 911) will enforce the new regulations, please contact them if you ever feel unsafe.

Certifications are not required for any sales persons you invite to your home, the delivery of newspapers, the sale of products sponsored by public, parochial or private schools, political communications, or anyone that is disseminating information without soliciting funds for service.

Residents may now also add their addresses to the Orange Township “Do Not Knock” Registry. This registry lists the addresses of those that Do Not desire to be solicited by door-to-door sales, and prohibit the vendors from knocking on your door. The up-to-date list of registered addresses is provided to all registered vendors, and is currently visible for review on the Township website (www.orangetwp.org).
